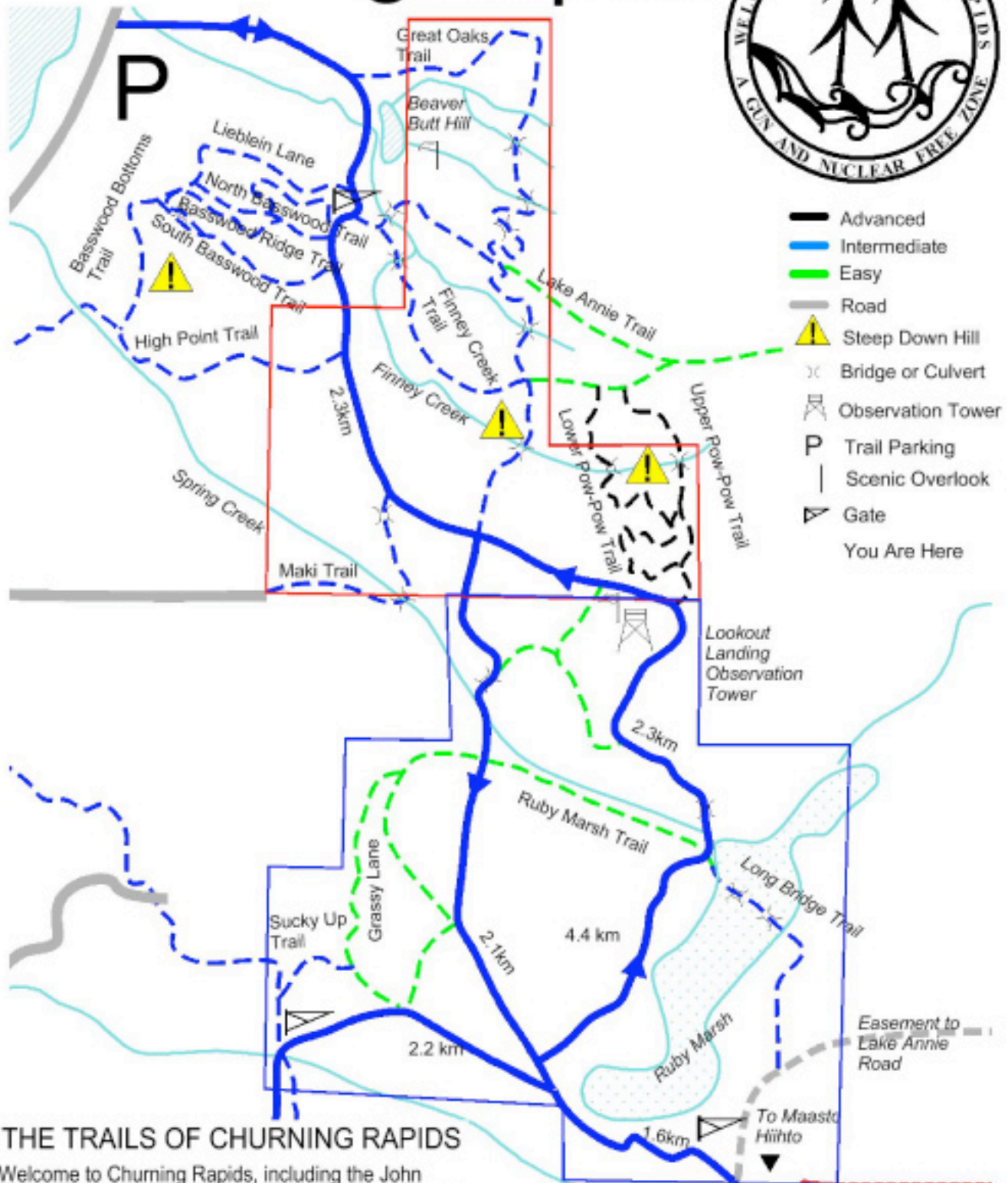


Churning Rapids

Those of you on foot, snowshoe, ski, horse, or bicycle have at 'em. If you came by motorized vehicle, park it at the gate and enjoy the quiet.

Some of the trails extend beyond the property line. Permission to use these connecting trails should be obtained from the owner. The Churning Rapids trails connect to the Maasto Hiihto trails of Hancock at the southwest and southeast corners of the map.
