Fiduciary and management authority

Approve Center budget or work with Committee to revise as necessary

Hire Center staff and handle facility contracts, under advisement of Marsin Center Committee

Review all Center related reports

Elected by KLT members to 3-year term, must take off one year after serving two consecutive terms

Meet bimonthly

Center User Groups

Commit to use in keeping with mission and goals of Center

Apply for use and state intended scope and purpose of use

Provide input for Center development through annual user survey

Partner with KLT to support and advance Center mission and goals

Assist in stewardship of Center

Ensure Center is left in good condition following use and cover expenses for any damages (deposit required)

Report any maintenance needs at Center to KLT

Invited to serve on Marsin Center Committee

Provide diversity, continuity and specificity to Center development and oversight in keeping with goals and mission of Center

Develop annual budget adequately prioritizing administrative, operating and maintenance costs in keeping with master plan for Center

Review use requests and develop equitable annual schedule in keeping with user commitments to Center

Evaluate user satisfaction and effectiveness of Center

Evaluate Center Endowment Fund performance and management

Provide annual report with recommendations to KLT

Participate in review of Center staff and contracts

Members represent diversity of user/interest groups such as conservation, education, youth, elderly, handicapped, neighbors, local government, community organizations, and legal, financial and development advisors

Serve at discretion of KLT Board and peer Committee members, initially with no term limit

Meet at least twice annually
